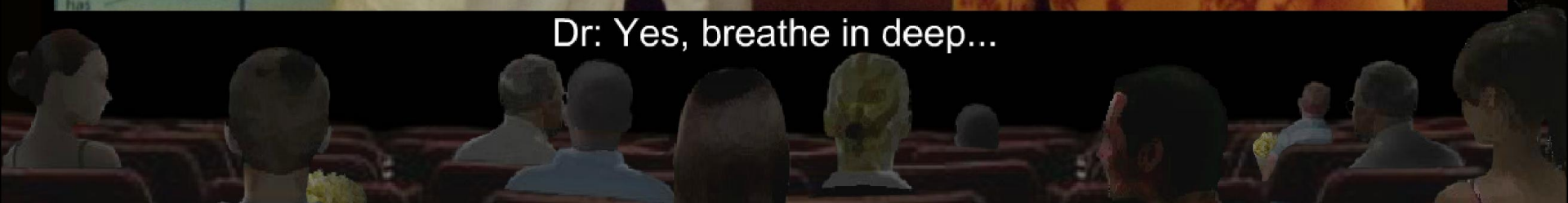




Dr: Open your mouth wide and say, 'Ah-h-h!' ...you've got 'flu' I suppose.

Patient: It seems to me I've broken my ankle...



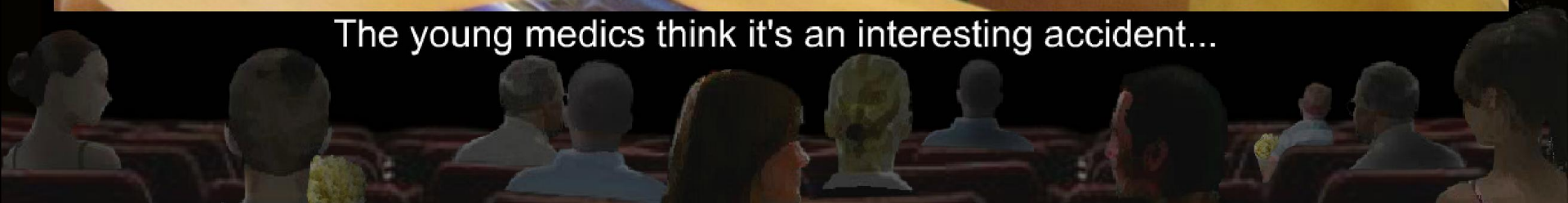
I was playing football when I heard a crunch... Oh, doc, it aches to walk...

The young medics think it's an interesting accident...

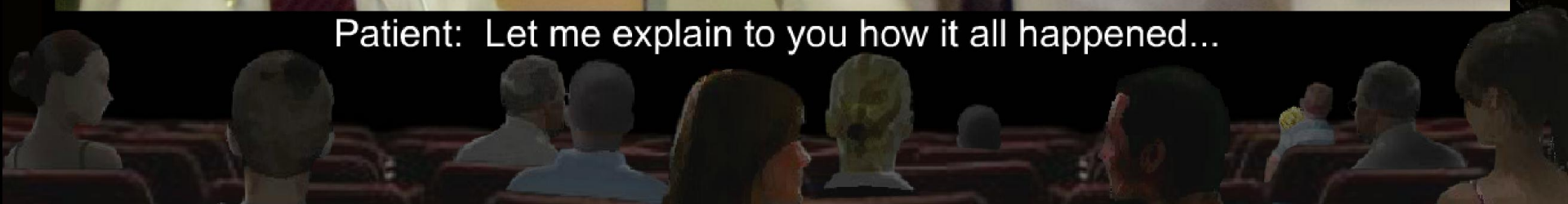




Dr: Does it ache here? Patient: Oh, YES... Doctor, I've hurt my wrist!



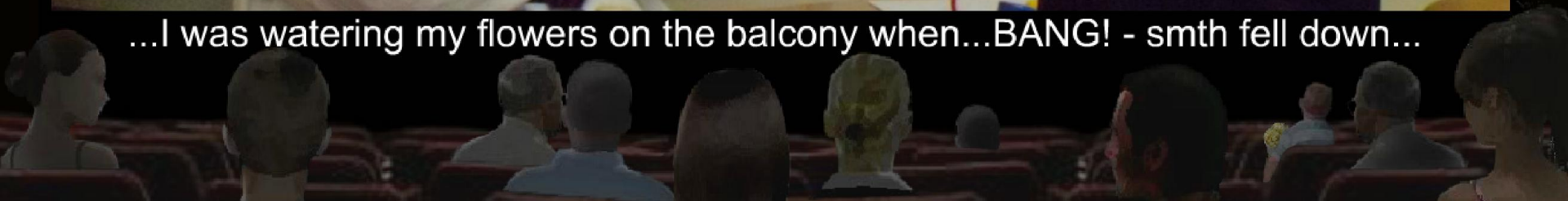
